Across from the Palais Royal and Comedie Francaise and two blocks from the Louvre Museum pyramid, this 1st-arrondissement property is the closest hotel to the Louvre's pyramidal entrance.

Sharing some of the traditional style of the Concorde chain's Crillon and Lutetia, this dramatic three-sided belle-epoque facade opens through a revolving door onto a small formal lobby. The shining marble, a grand staircase, soaring columns and radiant chandelier make a stunning first impression. Multiple doormen greet arrivals, a concierge—or two, during peak hours—dispenses their knowledge with a smile, and a well-trained front-desk staff efficiently handles all transactions.

Le Defender bar and lounge is an authentic Parisian watering hole, dim and rich with its red damask furnishings, black columns and dark green wallpaper. It's the price, not the cocktails, that are hard to swallow here. Live jazz plays here a couple of times a week.

The corner Brasserie du Louvre typifies the best of the genre, with brass rails booth seating and caricatures on the walls. It serves a good buffet breakfast and classic French fare at lunch and dinner among cafe tables and diners abuzz with Parisian energy. A wicker furnished alfresco section faces the street traffic.

The eight meeting rooms seat up to 200. The most popular of the bunch, Salon Rohan, is located on the ground floor. The business center

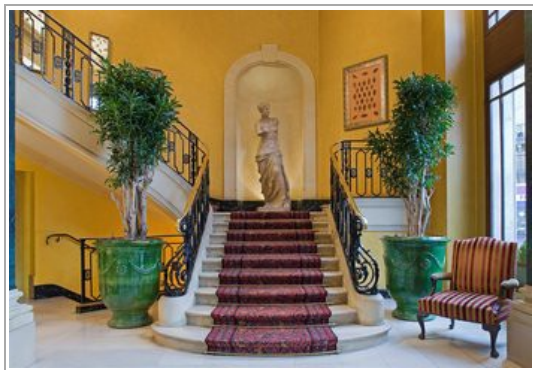
is well-equipped. The fitness room houses a variety of machines and free weights. Valet parking is available.

Wide hallways are decorated in red and green with fine woods and discreet lighting. The high-gloss wood doors open onto mostly average-sized standard, superior and deluxe rooms, and a mix of luxurious suites decorated by popular French interior designers. The style is a mishmash of successive renovations, yet comfortable and charming throughout. Some of the patina can be attributed to just plain wear. Still, standards are high, and cleanliness is never an issue.

A typical junior suite has royal blue and white decor with ceramic lamps, anteroom, sitting area, swagged drapes, doorbell, king-sized bed, Bose radio, robes and slippers. Others boast ruby reds, plummy purples and snowy whites.

Most rooms have French doors or casement windows opening to Juliette balconies. Courtyard-facing rooms are the most affordable, but





take in less-enticing interior garden views. Suites 101 and 121 are notable for their views of the Louvre, the Arc de Triomphe and La Defense. One suite honors the paintings of Camille Pissarro with modern appointments, floor-to-ceiling windows and a whirlpool tub that overlooks the Opera house.

Daylight pours into 80% of the baths, which are fitted with clunky handheld spray attachments, hair dryers, magnifying mirrors and Annick Goutal toiletries. Rooms are air conditioned, and complimentary Internet access, both wired and wireless, is provided. Flat-screen TVs and outrageously priced minibars are standard issue, but coffeemakers are missing.

Room service runs around the clock, but the English-speaking staff is a bit indifferent to the tourist crowd despite the groups that often grace the entrance. This hotel is now smoke-free.

This hotel keeps its guests engaged with an elegant traditional atmosphere that is formal enough to feel important, and a high-brow authenticity that tourists love. This is a better option than the Cambon, but with higher prices.
